THE PRODUCER COMPLIANCE SCHEME FOR THE WEEE REGULATIONS

The WEEE regulations are now in place! Companies in the UK who produce, import and supply electrical and electronic equipment must register with an approved Producer Compliance Scheme.

If you import, manufacture or sell your own brand electrical or electronic equipment (EEE) you will have to comply with the regulations. Act now to make sure you comply on time and at the lowest cost.

WEEECOMPLY is an approved Producer Compliance Scheme. Membership is open to all obligated companies. We will take on your producer obligations and comply on your behalf and at the lowest cost.

WEEECOMPLY is run by Complypak, a company with a track record of compliance with the packaging regulations at the lowest cost.

What are the WEEE Regulations?

The Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) Regulations are being introduced in response to the WEEE Directive that was introduced in 2003.

Who is a 'Producer'?

"Producers" are either a) companies who supply on into the UK their own brand electrical equipment (whether they manufactured it themselves or it was manufactured by others) or b) importers of electrical and electronic equipment.

Is all electrical equipment covered by the regulations?

Most electrical and electronic equipment (EEE) is included, but there are some exemptions. Equipment that is part of another type of equipment or that is part of a fixed installation, medical equipment, filament light bulbs and military EEE is excluded.

I am a Producer. What are my legal obligations?

As a producers you will have an obligation to:

1. mark equipment with a special "crossed-out" wheellie bin symbol.
2. register with a Producer Compliance Scheme like WEEECOMPLY.
WEEECOMPLY is a fully approved scheme and able to accept your registration now.
3. Supply data each quarter on the amount of electrical equipment place on the market
4. Fund the treatment, recovery and recycling of WEEE based on the amount you place on the market.

What are the fees?

How will I have to fund treatment and recovery of WEEE?

For household equipment, Producers are legally obliged to fund the treatment and recovery of WEEE that has been separately collected by the public. WEEECOMPLY complies on behalf of members by collecting and recycling of household WEEE at the lowest cost to members. WEEECOMPLY will charge the cost to members quarterly.

Producers supplying to businesses have separate obligations to fund the treatment of equipment at the end of its life.
